Light Forms UAB, a company that started its operations in Lithuania at the end of 2020, is implementing an 18-month project to improve the professional competences of its employees in order to further strengthen its position, grow and become more competitive in the lighting equipment manufacturing market.

The project, which started on 15 February 2022 and is entitled Light Forms' investment in the development of the skills of production workers, aims to develop the competences of workers in the field of production of lighting equipment, to ensure the continuous development of their skills and to encourage them to adapt to changes in the economy. Given that the rapid expansion of the company's activities, the development of technology and innovation increase the need to transfer specific competences and knowledge to the company's employees, the project activities will train assemblers, welders, painting, CNC machine and wire processing operators, warehouse workers, product testers and production specialists.

The project is planned to train 65 employees, providing them with new skills that will help them to perform their job functions more efficiently and to guarantee a higher quality of the products they produce, thus helping them to establish themselves in the existing market. The in-house training organised is focused namely on the specific production processes, solution of practical situations in the workplace and is directly linked to the day-to-day work functions.

The project is implemented within the measure 09.4.3-ESFA-K-805 Human Resources Invest LT+ under Priority 9 of the Investment Programme of the European Union Funds for 2014-2020 Public Education and Enhancement of Human Resource Potential. The project will also contribute to the first objective of the Programme for Investment Promotion and Industrial Development for 2014-2020 To Increase Direct Investments in the Manufacturing and Service Sectors and the third objective of the Programme To Provide Lithuanian Businesses with Competitive Human Resources. The project activities are scheduled to end in August 2023.
